Suggested memory work review schedule for a four-day week. Review memory work according to week listed (e.g., "W1" stands for "Week 1"). Memory work can be Scripture, facts, poetry, Shakespeare - whatever you would like your family to memorize.

4-day weekly schedule for practicing U.S. geography and incorporating U.S. history and science readings and/or activities. Lower Grammar students can trace a USA map daily and read about or color a coloring page for each state. Upper Grammar students can learn to draw the USA by heart using the Draw USA book. 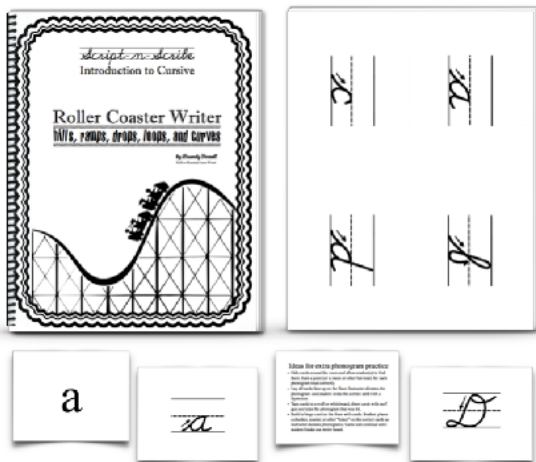

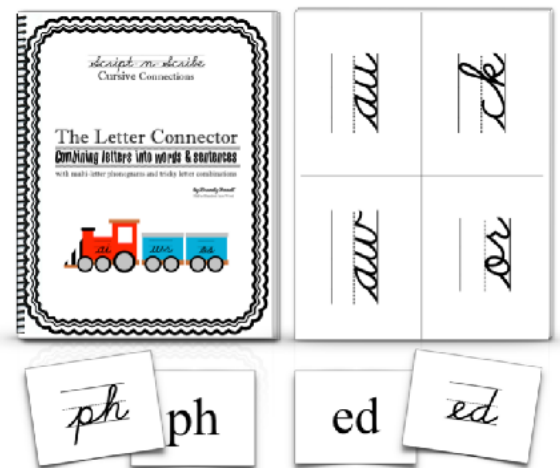
